A Treehouse at Browns Corner!

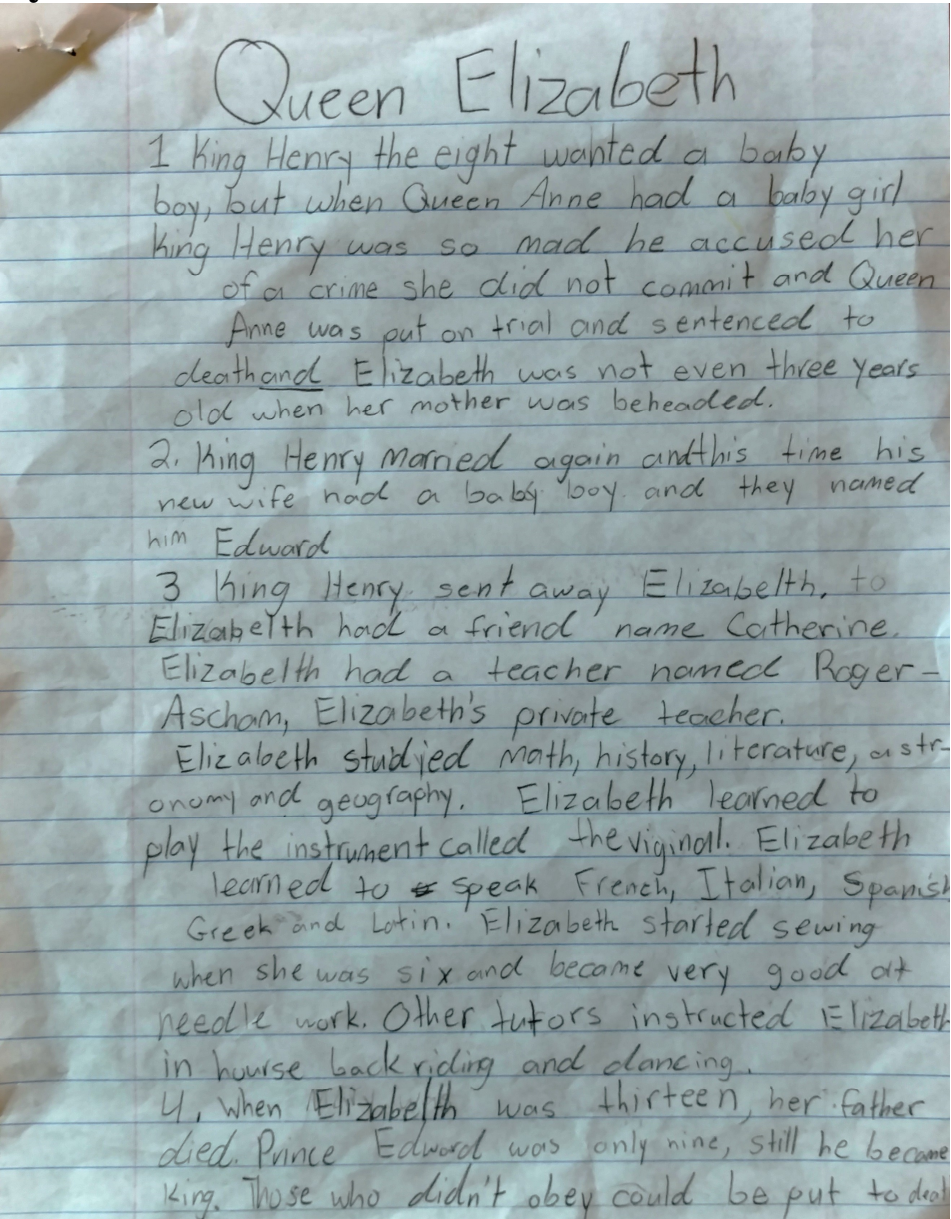
During Memorial Day weekend, the Sweeney kids stayed at Browns Corner while their parents went on vacation. Grampa and Tyler worked on building a treehouse.
